Future expenses:

Nordic: Gift card(s) for Joe who volunteered a lot this past winter. Craig is considering bringing varsity to Giants Ridge for the Mesabi Invite or a separate trip to Giants Ridge to train on the State Race course. They also need a flag for their tent, to make it easier to find. Craigs plans to buy new skis too, but that will likely come out of the school budget.

Girls Track: nice speaker with microphone (about \$350) and volunteer gifts at the end of the season

Boys Track: will need pole vault pits and poles sometime in the next 3 to 7 years, but hoping that it will be in the district budget

Track Fundraising

Girls Track is signed up for the Egg your Yard fundraiser, but they are looking to pass it off to another team.

The coaches were asked to take over the Outlaw run and are considering it, but after a discussion it is likely that they will ask the YMCA to partner with this, so that the Y can do most of the logistics and the teams can continue to do water stops and help promote it and hopefully still make \$1000 for the team through this event.

Donation Platforms

Coach Smith talked with the basketball booster club and they use someone on the club's personal venmo and then have a basketball account attached to the personal venmo and that can be transferred to the booster checking account. This would work until that person leaves the group and then a new venmo would need to be set up. And only if a booster club member wants to have it on their personal venmo.

Nicole has offered to have her name attached to the venmo, and it could go through her account—she would need to transfer the money to the Booster Club checking account periodically. Would that work for you, Nicole?

There is concern that the treasurer would have to sort through where the money goes, but Dave brought up that the money that comes in could just be split in half for boys and girls cross country during cross country and the between the girls and boy track during track season, to streamline it.

Matt is doing more research about other options and getting back to us.
